

## How to achieve 99 percentile in GMAT math

Practising often will also help you learn to solve problems the quickest way. If you think you need to use a complicated formula for any of the problems, think again. Find out about any possible shortcuts to working a problem before the test date.

### 4) Take practice tests often

Besides just being familiar with the types of questions asked in the exams, you still have to carry out plenty of practices with simulated tests. This will further increase your familiarity with the format of the test.

### 5) Choose the right study material for your self

Given recent developments with the sale of GMAT CD/DVD, audio books and flash cards, the search for the best study guide has become extremely challenging. So instead of being led to believe a certain GMAT material is the best, choose the best material that you believe will work for you.
